Methodology

National phone survey of 1,000 Registered Voters.

This survey took place January 12-17 among registered voters nationally. Data shown in this deck is among registered voters unless otherwise noted.

Margin of error for the full sample is +/-3.2 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence level.


Of the 1,000 respondents, 67 percent were interviewed via cell phone in order to accurately sample the American electorate.



Democrats have 10-point margin in 2020 ballot, with other at 8%



Democrats fully consolidated. GOP less.


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Democrat winning independents and 1/4 of moderate GOP


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Among Republicans & Republican-leaning independents.

Blowout numbers in base, while white working class men & women split

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
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Trump job performance


Do you approve or disapprove of the way Donald Trump is handling his job as President?





Both sides are very interested in 2020 election just months after midterm


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Wrong track numbers up as government shutdown continues
