Sample methodology

• Democracy Corps conducted a web survey with 2,710 voters from September 13 to September 19, in the presidential, House seats and US Senate battlegrounds for the 2024 general election. The data include a **base sample** of 1,414 registered voters representative of the battleground states and Congressional districts overall, with oversamples of 630 Black voters, 594 Hispanic voters, and 413 Asian American or Pacific Islander voters. The oversample data are statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, age, and gender composition reflects that of projected 2024 general election voters in the collective battleground.

- Harris is ahead in the Rust Belt states (829 sample), with a lead comparable to those of the
 public polls. That multiple surveys give her in a 2-point lead in each state means she is much
 more likely to occupy the White House.
- But Trump has successfully focused on the issues that are animating the desire for change prices and cost of living, immigration and border, and wanting change from Biden. He has changed the likely electorate, so the race is currently tied in the Rust Belt and Southeast (423 sample). With the Hispanic vote far short of 2020 and earlier, the mountain states (Arizona and Nevada) look the hardest.
- But this is still Harris' race to win. Democrats are running well in the House battleground districts and Senate races. Harris' overall vote was stable from pre-convention, making gains with whites under 45 years & college women. Trump gained from the 3 percent RFK voters; 90 percent disapproved of Biden. Trump's base of voters became more engaged, while Harris' less. And Harris lost support and turnout with her own working class supporters, concentrated among Hispanics, white unmarried women, and working class women.
- This survey shows how readily these trends can be reversed and how much room to gain with Hispanic voters.





- This race structure is unbelievably stable, with virtually no change in percent saying country headed in wrong direction and who is better on the list of 16 issues. Harris has gained on women's rights, and also who is for working people and not for the rich. But Trump's focused campaign has only shifted the likely electorate to be in an even darker mood.
- The reason I say this is Harris' race to win is because everything tested in this poll comes from
 Harris' speeches and ads. She has to be focused on the voters' top issues above all; prices,
 the cost of living, and inflation which is the animating issue in the Rust Belt and Southeast,
 and among white millennials, unmarried women, working class women, Blacks, and Hispanics,
 She has to focus on the changes she'll bring and contrast against Trump.
- Stop thinking Trump is hurting himself by the outrageous things he is saying about immigration. It has helped push up what is the top issue and raised his base's determination to vote. This race will change when the Harris campaign is as consumed with the cost of living and speaks about almost nothing else.





- Harris focusing on prices and bringing change on her economic policies and contrast with Trump are likely to put Harris is a stronger position. It will change the electorate, motivate the Democrats' base, and win back white working class women, moderate Democrats, and independents.
- The forward message has to be about people seeing change. A plurality of Black voters say we are headed in the wrong direction, joined by 60 percent of Hispanics, white unmarried women, and millennials. They respond strongly to the tests here.
- Trump's strongest messages are "Trump standing up for you and bringing back Trump's prosperity" and "you being killed by high prices and low wages." His strongest policies are his proposed punitive tariffs and deporting many immigrants. Don't underestimate his current attack on transgender operations.
- Harris strongest message starts with her attack on Trump's sales tax and her policies to cut middle class taxes for 100 million paid for by taxing billionaires.





- Here is Harris' strongest message: "Donald Trump's economic plan is really a Trump Sales Tax on
 every purchase. It is a 20% tax on everyday goods American families need to get by. It is an extra
 \$4,000 each year for those families. His plan would increase inflation, making it harder for
 working families to afford basic necessities. Under my economic plan, we'll lower the cost of
 living by investing in American manufacturing, cutting taxes for the middle class, and making big
 corporations pay their fair share."
- Her strongest policy? "Will pass a middle-class tax cut that will benefit more than 100 million Americans paid for by raising taxes on billionaires. No one making below \$400,000 a year will see any tax increase." Almost half of voters and two-thirds of Black respondents choose the expanded permanent Child Tax Credit and \$6,000 help in first year.
- And finally, the campaign talking about Harris' immigrant mother and her prioritizing the Hispanic community who will help her win shifts the vote significantly.
- This really is an election that is Harris' to win.



 Democrats run well in House & Senate races, except for changed electorate



























- Ban federal funding for gender-affirming care for minors, ban transgender athletes from competing based on gender identity, and support a bill defining gender as strictly male or female at birth.







Key Trump base groups respond favorably to tariffs











Project 2025 full attack statements

- Project 2025 aims to roll back environmental regulations by cutting climate protections and programs, replacing climate advisors with fossil fuel lobbyists, and deregulating big corporations in the oil industry, removing regulations that help protect the environment.
- Trump promises to use policies laid out in Project 2025 to dismantle the Affordable Care
 Act, cut Social Security and Medicare, and rip away protections for preexisting health
 conditions. It'll allow drug companies to jack up the prices.
- Project 2025 would abolish the Department of Education, cut school lunch programs, and instead utilize school vouchers and charter schools at the expense of public education, and Trump would implement book bans nationwide.
- The policies in Project 2025 would put immigrants in mass detention camps, ripping them away from their homes, their schools, because Trump calls them 'animals' who 'poison the blood' of America.






Project 2025 full attack statements – continued

- His project will allow employers to stop paying overtime for hourly workers but give tax handouts to the ultra-wealthy and big corporations. The tax cut he's proposed is for \$5 trillion over the next 10 years, which would widen income inequality.
- Trump will eliminate the civil service. They would use Project 2025 to purge the government of thousands of civil servants and replace them with unqualified MAGA loyalists who take a loyalty oath to Trump beforehand.
- Trump's Project 2025 would enact a national abortion ban, remove mentions of "abortion" and "reproductive health" from agency materials, would reverse the FDA's approval of abortion medication, and will criminalize the shipping of abortion medications.
- The proposed policies in Project 2025 would go after marriage equality, repeal antidiscrimination protections for LGBTQ+ students, reinstate the transgender military ban and expel transgender service members.
- Trump's Project 2025 advocates for more guns in public spaces and supports arming teachers in schools. The plan does nothing to address gun violence and plays to the hands of the gun lobby.












The Hispanic immigrant mother and priority message raises margin from 10 to 15 for those who heard them
