

President Biden makes gains in an election that he can win Report on post-State of the Union battleground poll

METHODOLOGY


Democracy Corps conducted a web survey with 2,525 voters from Mar 28 – Apr 2, 2024, in the presidential, House seats and US Senate battlegrounds for the 2024 general election. The data include a base sample of 1,390 registered voters, with oversamples of 516 Black voters, 501 Hispanic voters, and 478 Asian American voters. The oversample data are statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, age, and gender composition reflects that of projected 2024 general election voters in the collective battleground.

The total data set of 2,525 registered voters (1,390 base sample plus 1,135 oversample of voters of color) were weighted down to an effective sample size of 1,000, representative of the battleground states and districts. The sample used voter file data for proportions from Catalist on race, age, and gender, to ensure that difficult-to-reach conservative subgroups by race, gender, and education were properly represented. The data are also weighted by cultural thermometers (NRA and pro-life groups), to offset the bias of on-line panels. Finally, data are weighted by recalled 2020 Trump vote of white working class, white women, Blacks, Hispanics, Asian, and young voters.

The total sample of 2,500 Registered Voters (1,000 Weighted) includes:

- 1,248 Registered Voters in Senate Battleground States (546 Weighted)
- 435 Registered Voters in Congressional Battleground Districts (168 Weighted)
- 1000 White Voters (750 Weighted)
- 516 Black/African-American Voters (120 Weighted)
- 501 Hispanic/Latino Voters (80 Weighted)
- > 478 Asian American (Asian) Voters (30 Weighted)

Key findings - 1

- I now believe that Joe Biden can win re-election.
- In November, Democracy Corps showed the same difficult race as the public polls. I expected and wrote that the race would get more difficult because of continued inflation, the growing border crisis and a campaigns strategy that sought to educate its diverse base how much they had benefited from Biden's policies. I think that misread those voters. I thought the elites underestimated how much people feared a continuation of Biden. And with his age, I wasn't sure key voting groups were just tuning him out.
- The president's State of the Union, which emphasized a sharp contrast with Trump and description of the Biden team's work reversed the momentum, raised his approval rating and moved the race from a 5-point to a 3-point deficit in the battleground states. But the gains were greater in the places you would expect from the strategy. That meant voters were listening. The campaign got higher interest and increased their vote share with Black and Hispanic voters, white Gen Z and millennial voters, and white unmarried women, as well as moderate Republicans.
- Compared to Trump, Biden has a touch more loyalists, less vulnerable voters and more winnable voters. The Democrats are running well in the House and Senate battlegrounds, creating a more favorable ticket. In fact, both double haters and Robert F. Kennedy voters lean Democratic.



Key findings - 2

- While Biden has a lot of work to do on the border and other issues, he has made gains and achieved majority support on key voting issues: who is for the rich, climate change, women's rights, health care, protecting from an autocrat and securing democracy.
- But the Biden train does not make further gains with this strategy. We tested the best possible campaign as you
 will see below. It raised Biden's approval, but only reduced the margin a point to -2. Biden's robust soul of
 America message scored a -2 in vote reactions almost 10 points short of Trump''s Save America message.
- We still live in a country where three quarters say it is on the wrong track. For all our vote targets, it is over 90 percent. Voters are angry about inflation and the cost of living above all else and that is most true for the youngest. Black, Hispanic and Asian voters, worry a lot about crime, homelessness and immigration being out of control.
- People are much more worried about what happens with border and crime if Biden wins than what happens if Trump does. Slightly more people fear Biden continuing as president than Trump returning to the presidency. Trump is running an ugly and effective campaign leaves voters slightly more worried about Biden.
- Structurally, Trump loyalists are united and engaged to extraordinary levels. That means Republicans are 12 points more likely to choose the highest level on the interest ladder than Democrats and 6 points more likely to be voting for their nominee. And nearly 60 percent prioritize crime, the economy, China, immigration and the border.
- The progress of the first phase says this can be changed.



Key findings – 3

- Why do you say Joe Biden can win?
- Most important was voters heard his campaign strategy and moved accordingly. The shifts to Biden were well short of where he stood in 2020. And just continuing the strategy in the next phase is likely to leave Biden around 2 points back in the battleground.
- Most important was that the "empower the middle class" message that embodies all of Biden's policies wins by 7 points. It starts with recognizing the price challenges, but then focuses on shifting power away from biggest corporations to working people. It champions key Biden policies, but the most important will be taxing billionaires, while Trump doubles his corporate tax cut. It reassures on crime and the border and ends with encouraging the middle class to dream again.
- That message, combined with the specter of Trump horrors, cut the RFK vote in half and pushed Trump's vote to 44 percent.
- Once the campaign stops thinking women, Black, Hispanic and young (students) voters are voting on their identities, it will make big gains. We tested the "racial justice" ad word for word on Biden's accomplishments, and it ranked 8th with Black voters. Young people aren't going to be moved on student debt relief. They are focused on the cost of living more than any other voters.
- Hispanic voters won't move significantly until the president and campaign tell Hispanic voters how important they are to Democrats winning and how they are helping the hardworking middle class.




Key findings – 4


- Once you understand prices matter more than anything, the administration has achievements that really matter, starting with reducing health care costs and the expanded Child Tax Credit.
- Taxing billionaires is deeply popular with the public, as is shifting power away from Wall Street and the biggest corporations.
- There are so many targets once Biden moves into the next phase. Liberal Democrats are half the party, and they to hear about the cost of living, abortion and climate change. Over 70 percent of RFK voters and dual haters say the top problem is the cost of living.
- Soon Biden will have to take the lead in saying the border is out of control, decry Trump's veto and take unilateral steps that show he gets it and makes progress. His not making any gains on the border since the last poll, which means all Democrats are exposed. Crime and the border are very near the top for base voters.
- This poll is taken in the battleground districts and states where we have seen intense organization greatly raise engagement and support for Democratic candidates and initiatives. Stay tuned.




The voter choice scale shows somewhat more winnable race — with more loyalists, less vulnerable and more winnable








2024 FULL PRESIDENTIAL VOTE (PRES BATTLEGROUNDS)





Big rise in election interest among Blacks, Hispanics, Asians, and white college women, but well below prior elections; white college top all others








Right Direction Wrong Track


Family's Current Financial Situation (Percent)
























The Biden Campaign

The Biden campaign that we tested

- A list of 10 accomplishments of the Biden administration, including the new ad on racial justice.
- Each respondent read a major infrastructure project in their state.
- Afterwards, were asked again whether approve of Joe Biden and the bi-partisan infrastructure bill.
- 8 attacks on Trump and the Republicans in Congress
- Read 4 messages that come from the State of the Union and ad aired by the Biden campaign, including one on Gaza where the president has called on Netanyahu to do more to protect civilians
- They read the overall message that begins with Biden tackling the main problems of the country. [The text drawn from campaign ads.] It closes, it is a "battle for the soul of America."
- Finally, they read a list of horrible things that will happen in America if Trump reelected.



Biden accomplishments - full text

(HEALTH) The new law passed by Democrats capped out-of-pocket drug costs at \$2000, reduced insulin to \$35 a month, and allows Medicare to negotiate lower prescription prices for the first time.

(CHILD TAX CREDIT) Increased the Child Tax Credit received monthly that provided tax relief for poor, working, and middle-class families with children. It was the biggest tax cut for working families ever and it cut Black child poverty in half.

(ABORTION) He opposes Republican attempts to ban abortion and has taken executive actions to protect abortion access and improve contraception availability. He will restore Roe v. Wade as the law of the land.

(INFRASTRUCTURE) With bi-partisan support, is investing \$1.2 trillion in infrastructure to create jobs and spark economic growth through significant improvements in transportation, clean energy, and broadband access, with a focus on benefiting disadvantaged communities.

(BIG CORP) Passed law providing more funds to the IRS to crack down on tax evasion by the wealthy and big corporations, put in a 15 percent minimum tax so they pay taxes, and a 1 percent fee on stock buybacks used by big oil companies making super profits.

(ECONOMY) America's economy is the strongest in the world. The economy has created 14.8 million jobs, unemployment has been under 4 percent for two full years, and inflation has been at the pre-pandemic level of 2 percent over the last half year.

(CLIMATE) Passed first law that made historic investment in fighting climate change. It reduces what people spend on energy and reduces carbon pollution. It gives big tax credits to help families make their homes energy efficient, install solar panels and buy an electric vehicle. It saves the average family \$1800.

(MADE IN AMERICA) He is bringing manufacturing back to the U.S., with a \$13 billion investment in electric vehicles and \$24 billion in batteries and Chips plants located here. It is building in America by forcing federal government agencies to buy in America.

(UNIONS) Biden joined on the picket line to support workers. He has helped real wages increase by 3.5 percent, with the lowest-paid workers benefiting most. He extended overtime protections to over 3.6 million workers, and penalized Starbucks and Amazon with unfair labor practices.

(BORDER SECURITY) He backed the bipartisan group of Senators to create the toughest set of border security reform ever. Endorsed by the BorderPatrol Union. It added 1,500 border patrol agents, inspection detectors for fentanyl, 4,300 asylum officers, 100 new immigration judges, and the power to close the border. Trump blocked it.


(APPLE) Brought the first lawsuit in decades against Apple. It charged Apple with monopolizing the smartphone market through restrictive practices that hindered developers accessing other platforms. It charged Apple with raising costs for consumers.

(RACIAL JUSTICE) Since day one, he has prioritized equity and racial justice by signing an executive order aimed to address systemic disparities affecting various communities and ensuring the full and fair participation of all communities in American life..





State infrastructure projects – full text

[ARIZONA RESPONDENTS] To date, \$7.4 billion in Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding is headed to Arizona with over 610 projects identified for funding. Projects made possible by the Biden administration include widening I-10 in the Gila River Indian Community, modernizing the San Luis I Land Port of Entry, and upgrading the three decade-old central utility plant at the Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport.




Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President?












