The national web survey described

METHODOLOGY

Democracy Corps conducted a national web survey among 2,770 registered voters from Sept. 9-15, 2022. The data include a base sample of 1,270 registered voters, with large oversamples of 500 Black voters, 500 Hispanic voters, and 500 AAPI voters. The oversample data are statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, age, and gender composition reflects that of the estimated registered voters in the United States.

The total data set of 2,770 registered voters (1,270 base sample plus 1,500 oversample of voters of color) were weighted down to an effective sample size of 1,000, nationally representative of registered voters. Additionally, the data were weighted to an average of recent phone polls (or moving norm) on core cultural thermometers, and the 2020 vote was weighted to the moving norm among white working-class men and women, Black, Hispanic, and AAPI voters.

The total sample of 2,770 Registered Voters (1,000 Weighted) includes:

- > 839 Registered Voters in Battleground States/CDs (326 Weighted)
- 977 White Voters (720 Weighted)
- 632 Black/African-American Voters (120 Weighted)
- ➢ 604 Hispanic/Latino Voters (100 Weighted)
- > 530 Asian American (AAPI) Voters (58 Weighted)

Key Findings - 1

- Democrats have moved into a small 3-point lead in the generic ballot because their partisans are now equally engaged with Republicans and slightly more consolidated, as GOP fractures grow.
- But this is a volatile moment where two-thirds believe the country is on the wrong track, inflation puts cost of living to the top of issues to be addressed, crime and border issues could explode, and President Biden's 55-percent disapproval still creates a strong headwind for Democrats, despite recent gains.
- The good news is that the January 6th Committee, the abortion Supreme Court decision, Trump's intimidating reemergence and lawlessness, and the Democrats passing major legislation changed that. Since the July poll, Democrats have made major gains versus Republicans on which party is better on extremism, putting country over party, getting things done, the economy, and most important, helping with the cost of living. And while Democrats still trail Republicans by 8 points on the economy, they are now tied on the top problem, cost of living.
- Democrats only hold their vote in this poll when they embrace helping working people with the cost of living as their first priority. But it is not the only voting issue. They make further gains when they address abortion, assault weapons, and the Child Tax Credit as well.
- With two-thirds believing country on the wrong track and a big majority disapproving Biden, it is easy for Democrats to get it wrong. Engaging on the crime issue, for example, hurts Democrats. We get a reduced vote margin after we join the debate on funding and defunding the police. The biggest fear with Democratic control of government is Democratic cities facing rising homelessness, crime and attacks on police. So, this is not the time to elevate the crime issue.



Key Findings - 2

- And if you follow the lead of many national Democrats who are talking up the economy and good jobs and avoiding the cost of living, you get the worst possible outcome. We tested that message with half the respondents. They heard the Democrats talking about delivering for people on many issues and warning of MAGA Republican extremism that threatens your constitutional rights. After hearing that, the Democrats no longer led in the generic ballot.
- But fortunately, actual Senate and House campaigns are not delivering that message. NBC tests the message that Democrats are actually saying, and it starts with their advocacy for working people on the cost of living, "we need to keep delivering for working Americans by lowering costs, including health care and prescription drugs, and ensuring corporations pay their fair share." That message gives the Democrats a 7-point headwind over the message being delivered by the Republicans.
- So, Democrats hold or get to a 5-point lead when they contest the cost of living. You begin with what is happening
 with working people who are living paycheck to paycheck. You champion them against big corporations with huge
 profits that are driving up prices. Democrats did real things to help. Remind them. You cut taxes for the poor, working
 and middle class families, lowered health care, drug and energy costs. And contrast that with the Republicans who
 are protecting the big corporations and billionaires against paying higher taxes, on price gouging, and giving
 unlimited money to politicians.
- Our weapons are the things Democrats got done. Top of the list across the base are reducing health care costs. For millennials and unmarried women, it is also cutting their taxes all central to the cost of living equation. For under 50 white working class voters, the Child Tax Credit is as at very top key to their family finances. Republicans taking it away makes it the top attack for those voters. Hispanics, Gen Z, and millennials also cheer Democrats protecting abortion rights.
- Stop thinking of these policy advances as things that expired and put them into an election choice where Democrats will bring them with our 52-seat Senate majority and Republican control mean they are dead.



Key Findings - 3

 Democrats can push up the margin with direct attacks on Republicans and bringing them into the choice in this election. If Republicans get control, our base of voters and target women voters are worried they will ban abortions nationally. The white working class voters under 50 fear the loss of the Child Tax Credit. Democratic partisans also worry now about emboldened white nationalists and threats to democratic elections, as do Cheney conservatives. And the survey shows more of them can defect to the Democrats.

(DEMS FOR WORKING PEOPLE; GOP DOES BIG CORP BIDDING) Democrats say people are living paycheck to paycheck and working people haven't seen a real pay increase in years. Those in Washington don't get it. The big corporations and billionaires and their lobbyists are calling the shots. Democrats gave tax relief to the poor, working families, and the middle class, and reduced health care, prescription drug, and energy costs. With inflation killing people, they are going after the price gouging. Republicans get their money from big oil and drug companies, and they oppose tax relief for working people and raising taxes on billionaires. Democrats believe your hard work should be rewarded, and we will grow the middle class again.

- We will test shorter forms of this message, but as a start, we recommend our adaptation of the NBC poll conducted by Hart Research: "Democrats are helping hard working Americans by lowering costs, including health care and prescription drugs, and ensuring big corporations pay tax."
- We should evolve the MAGA message: "Republicans are extremists who are all in for billionaires, threaten future elections, won't raise assault weapons age to 21, and will make abortion illegal nationally."
- And speak directly to Hispanic and Asian American voters: you "played such a big role in building our economy, our industries and state and not enough leaders have acknowledged it." (Thank you, Mr. Odio.)
