- **Margin of error +/- 3.3 percent on likely voter data**

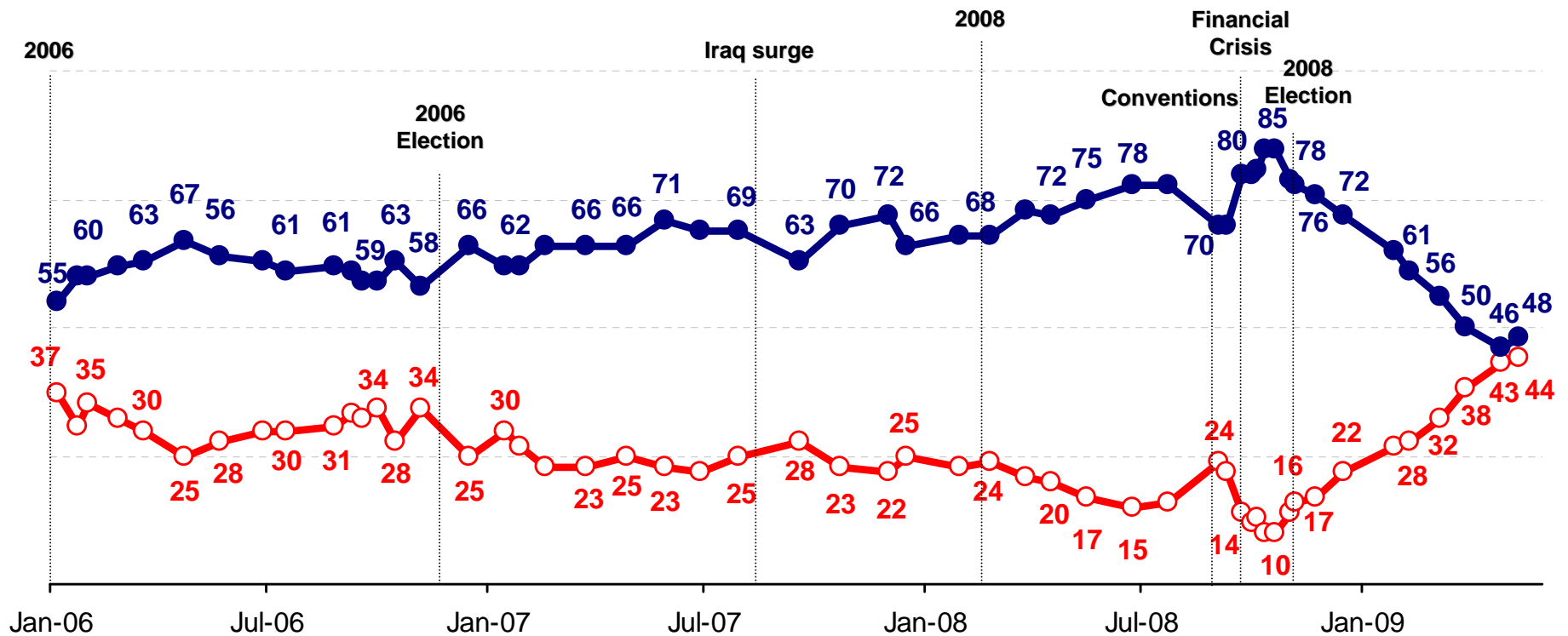

● Wrong track



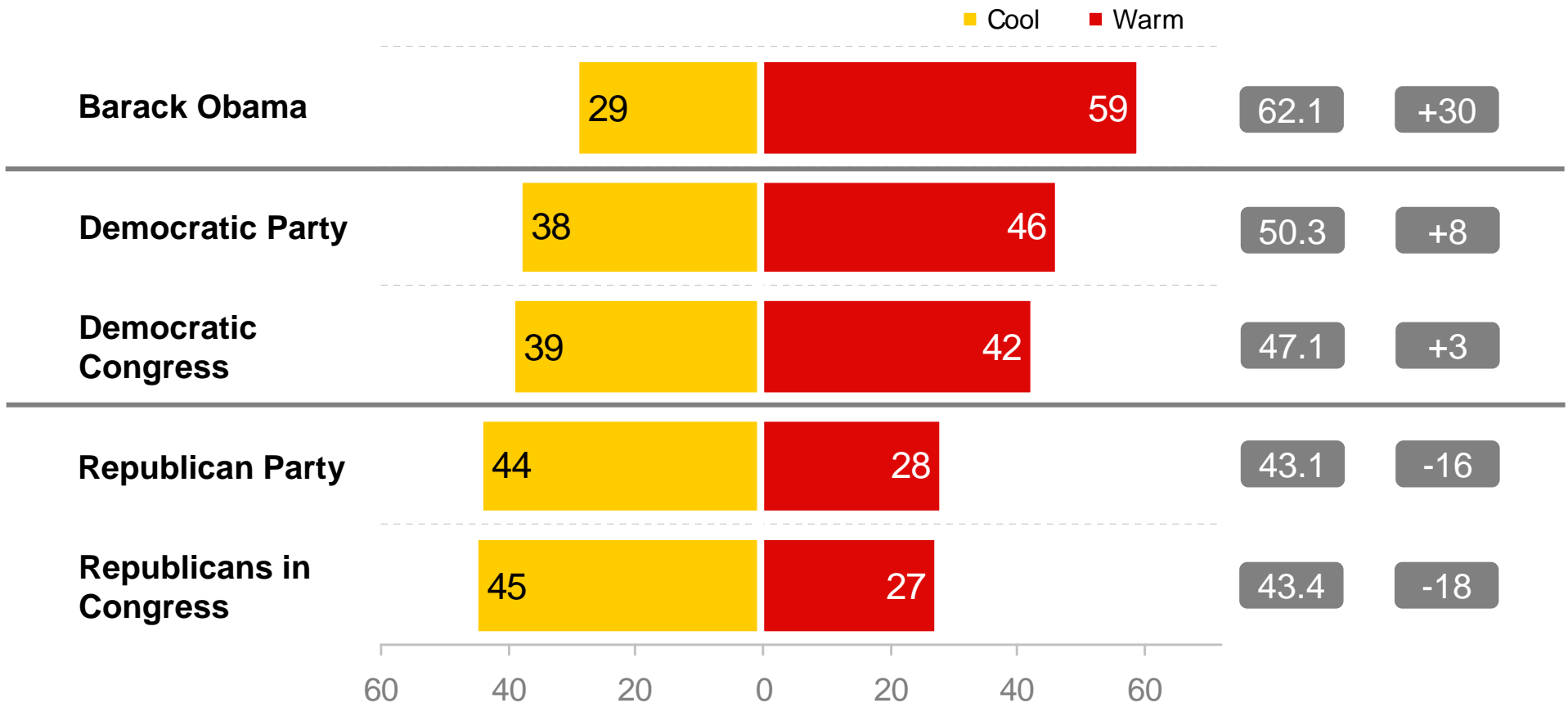

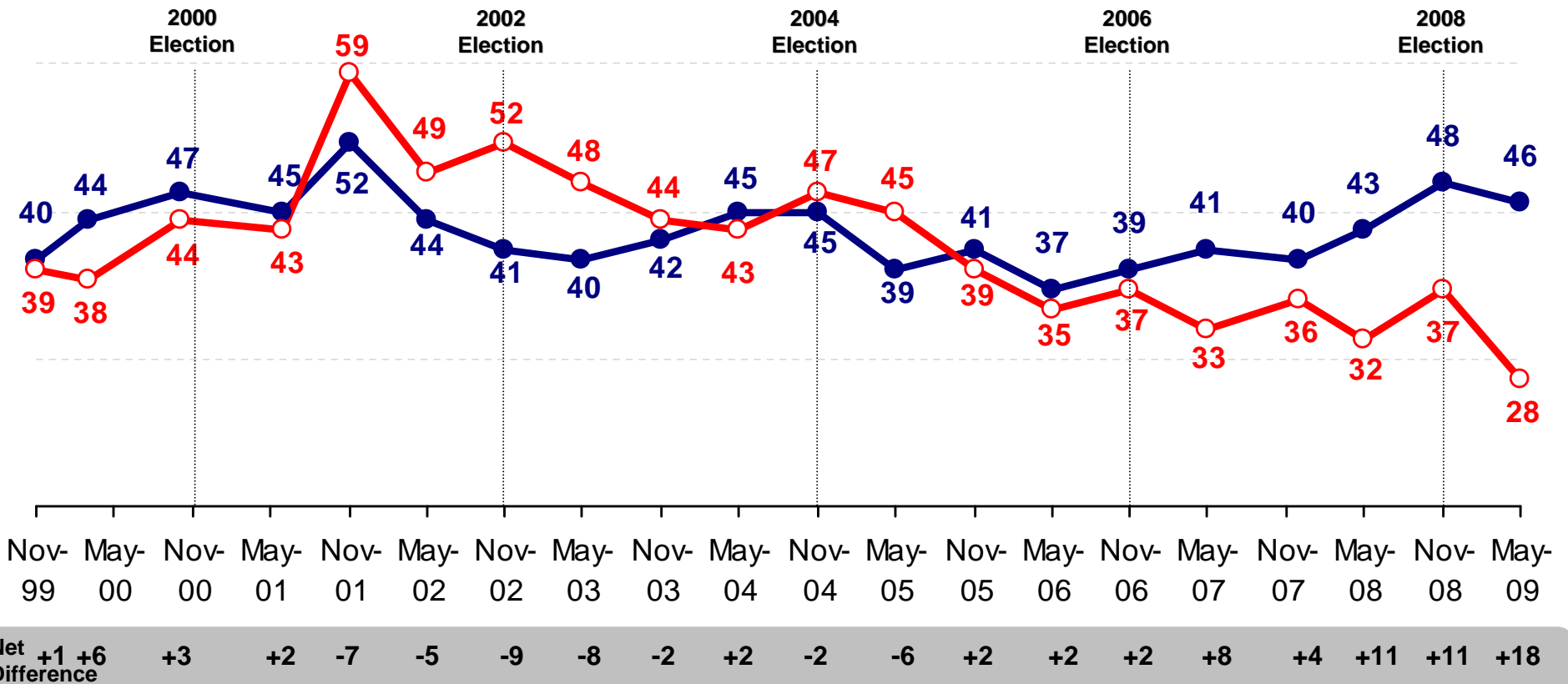

○ Republican Party



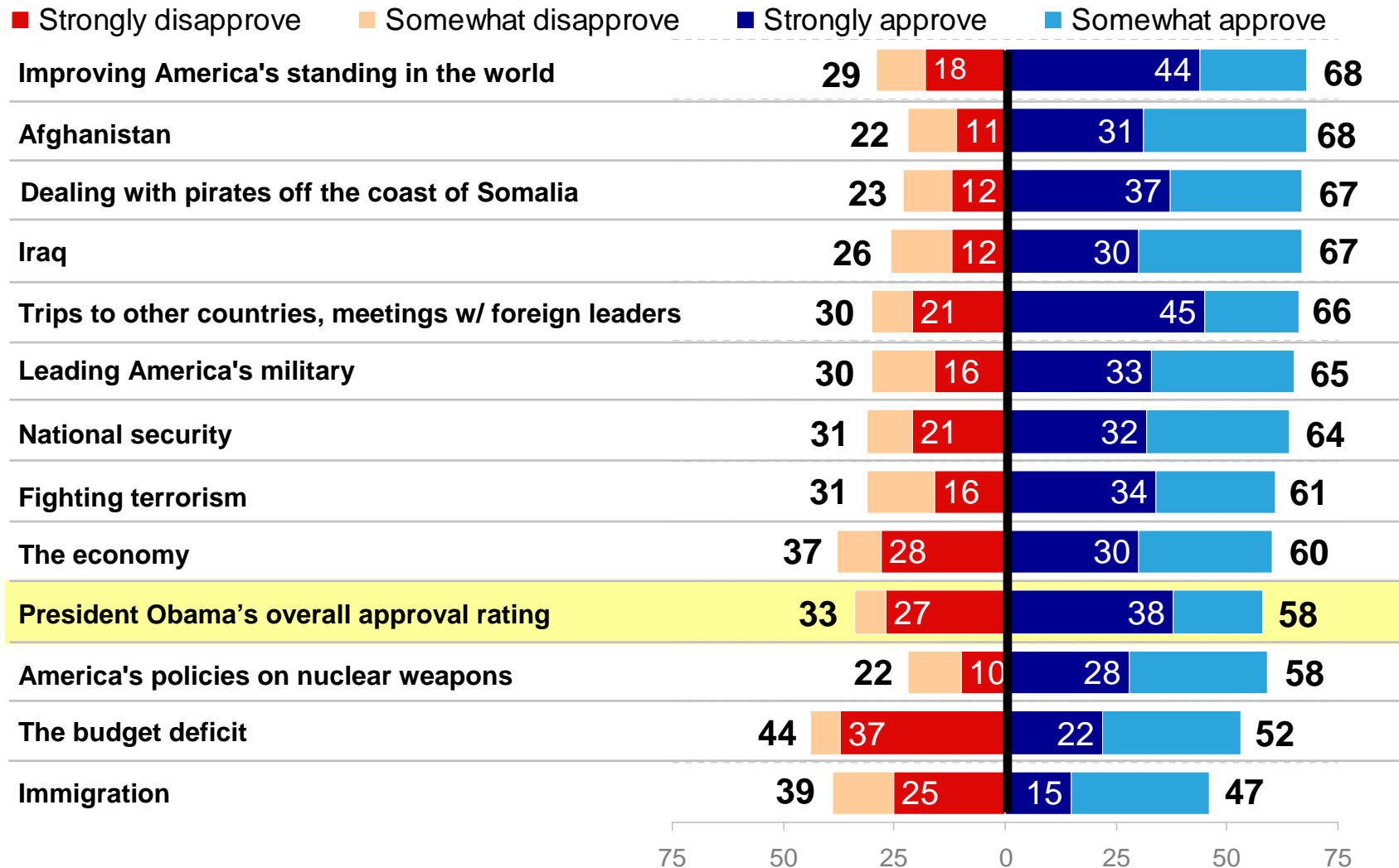

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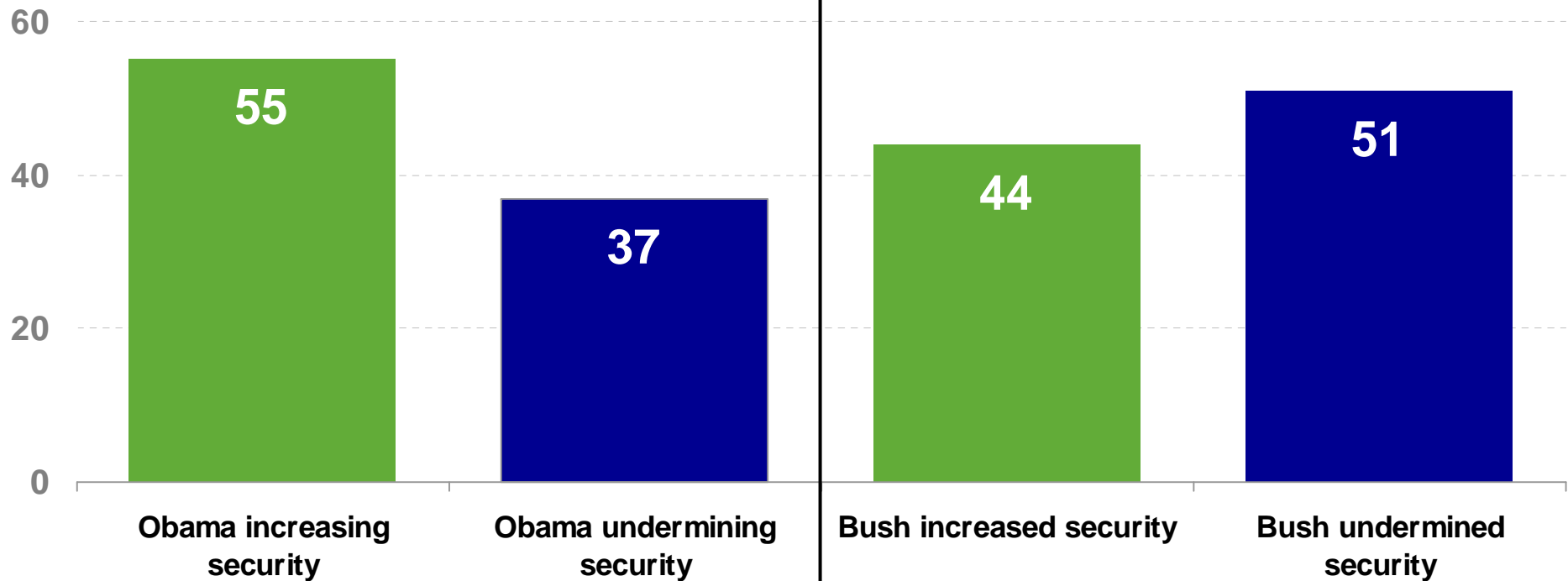

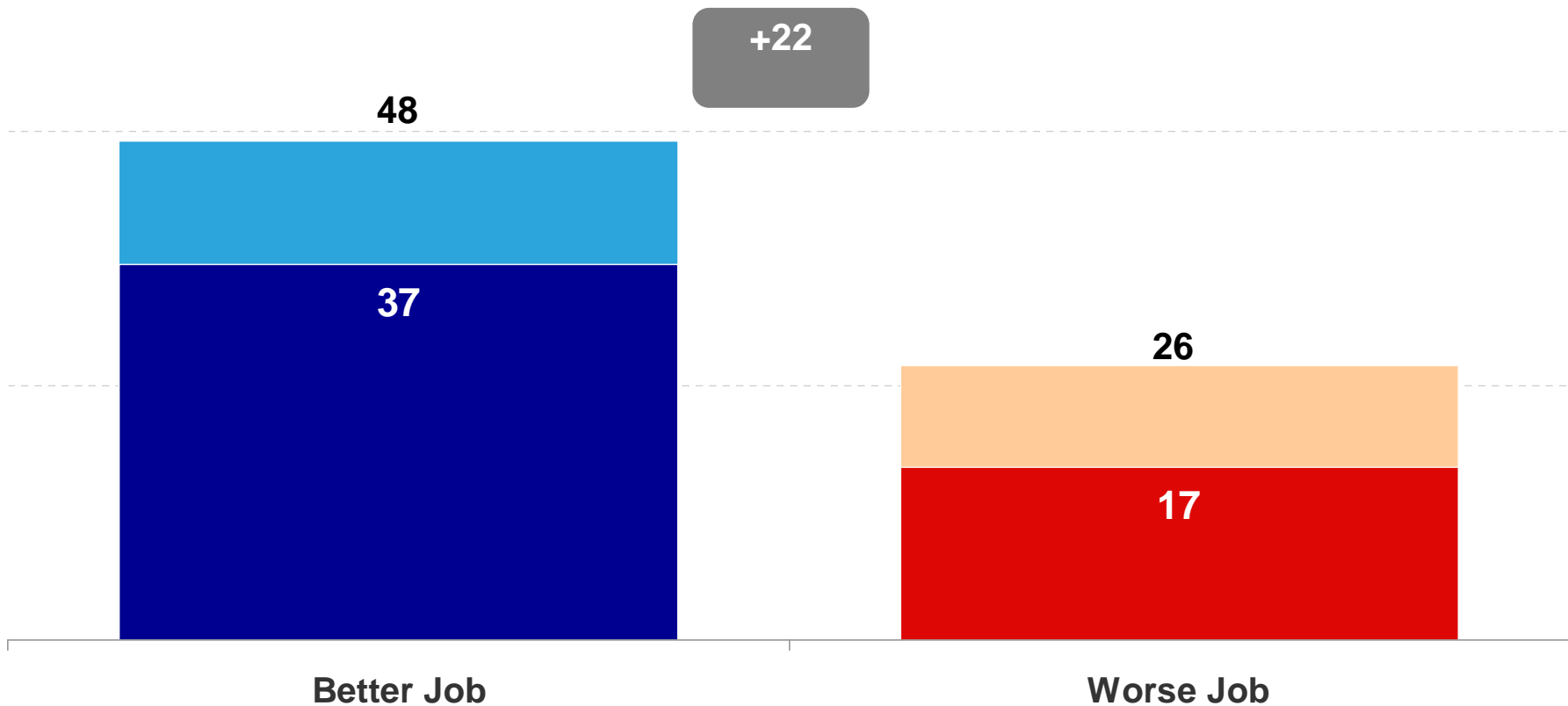

*When it comes to national security policy, do you think President Obama is doing better, worse, or about the same as President George W. Bush?*

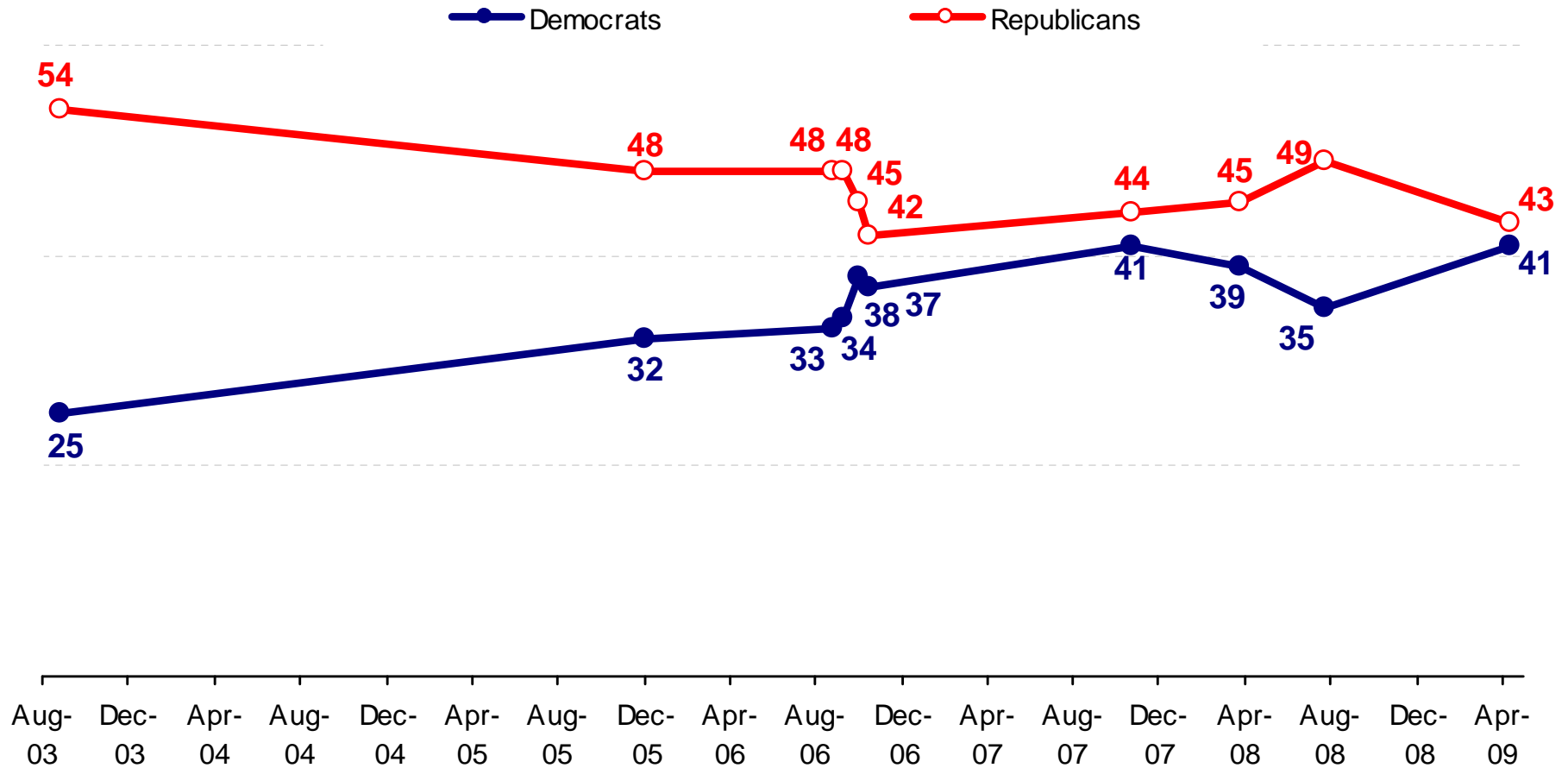

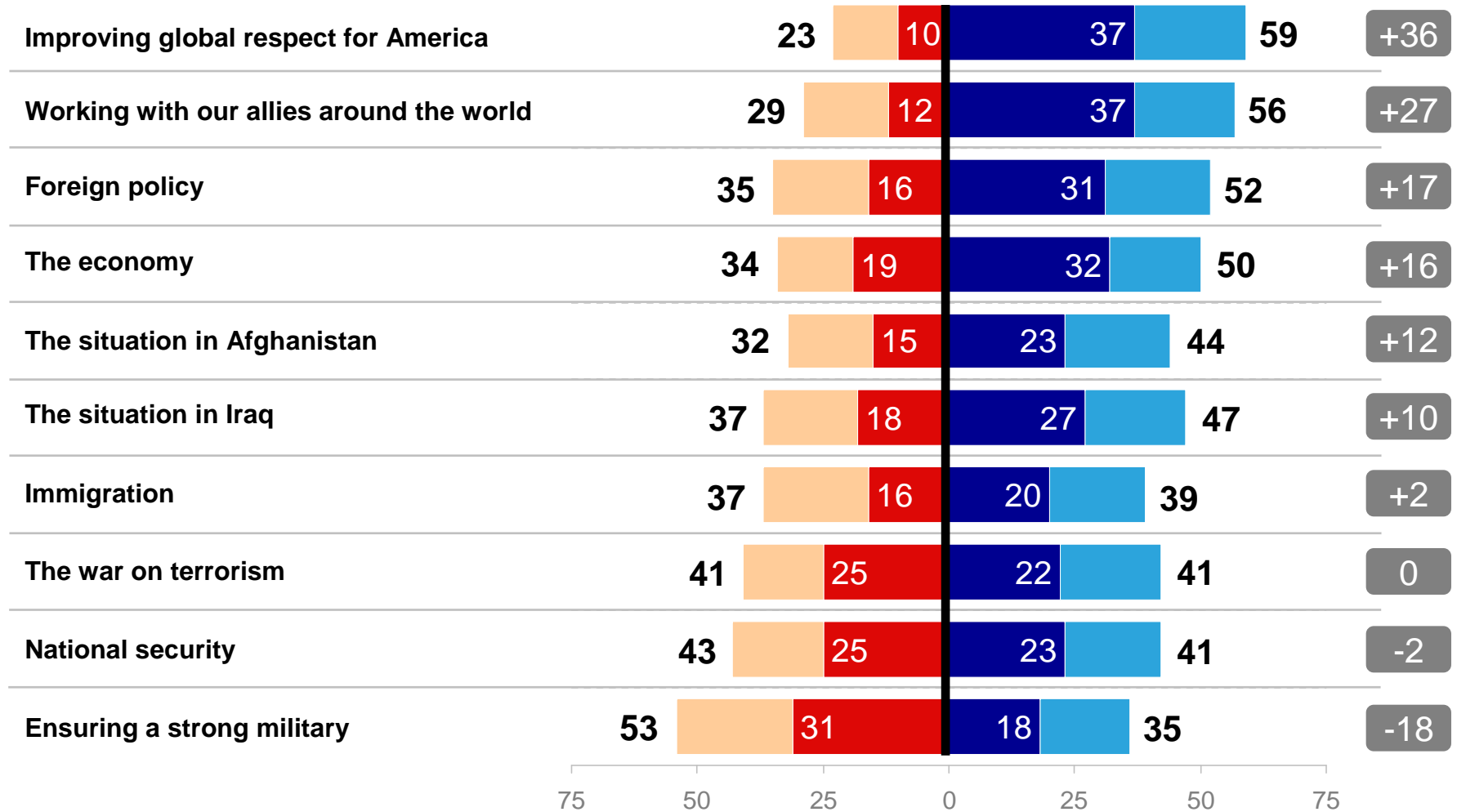


## Democrats favored on wide range of foreign policy issues

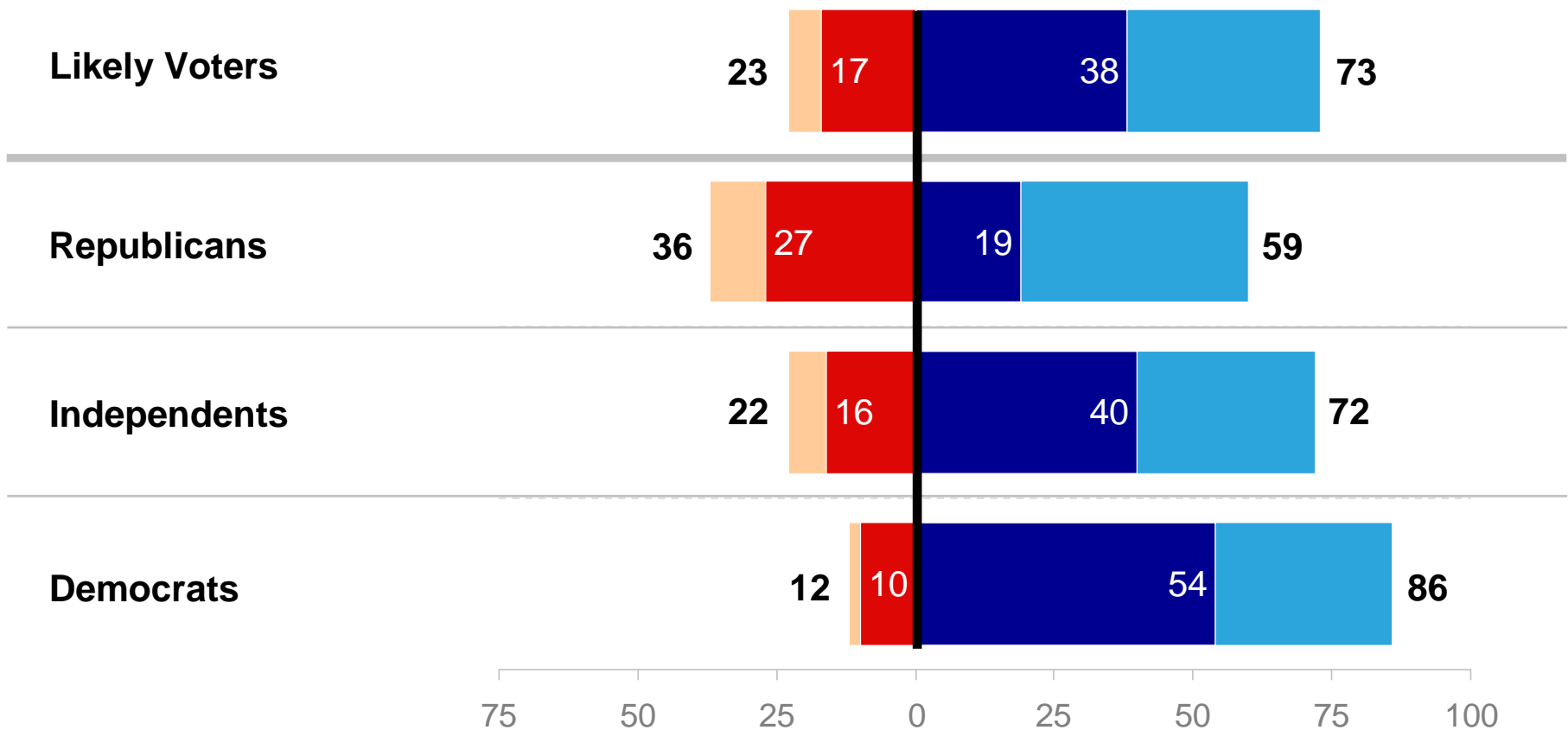

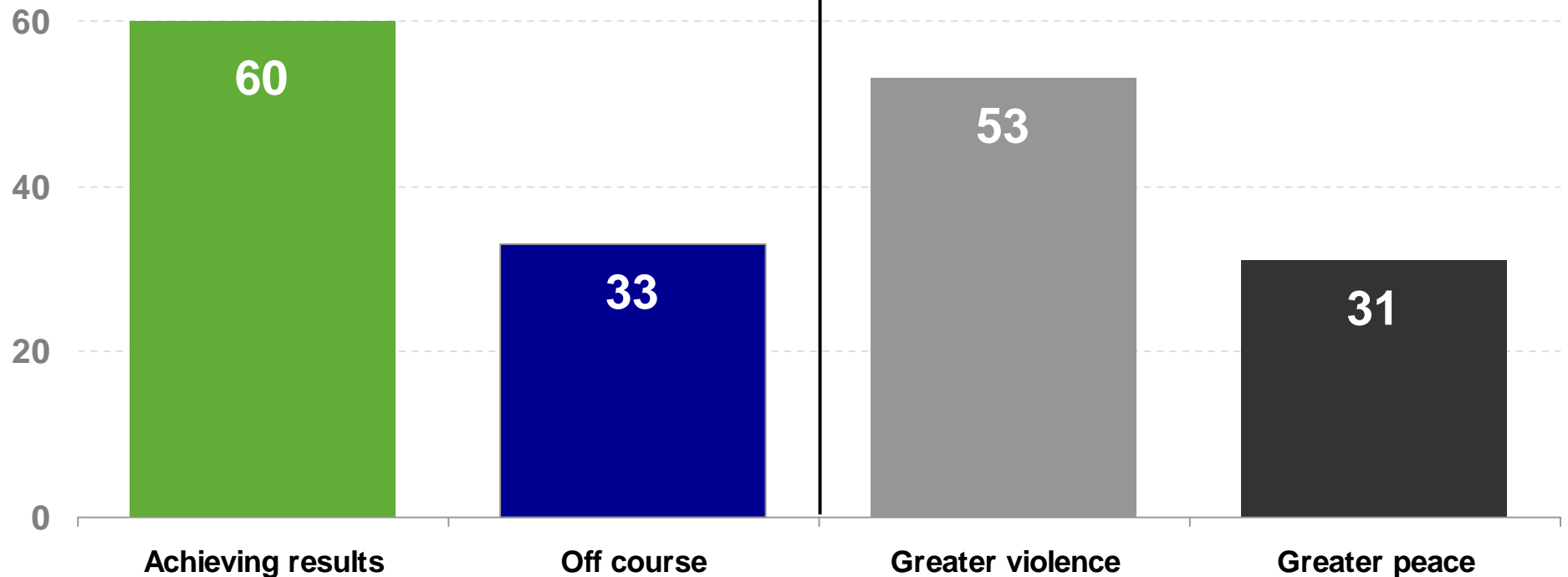


## Strategy in Iraq is achieving results, but withdrawal will create violence

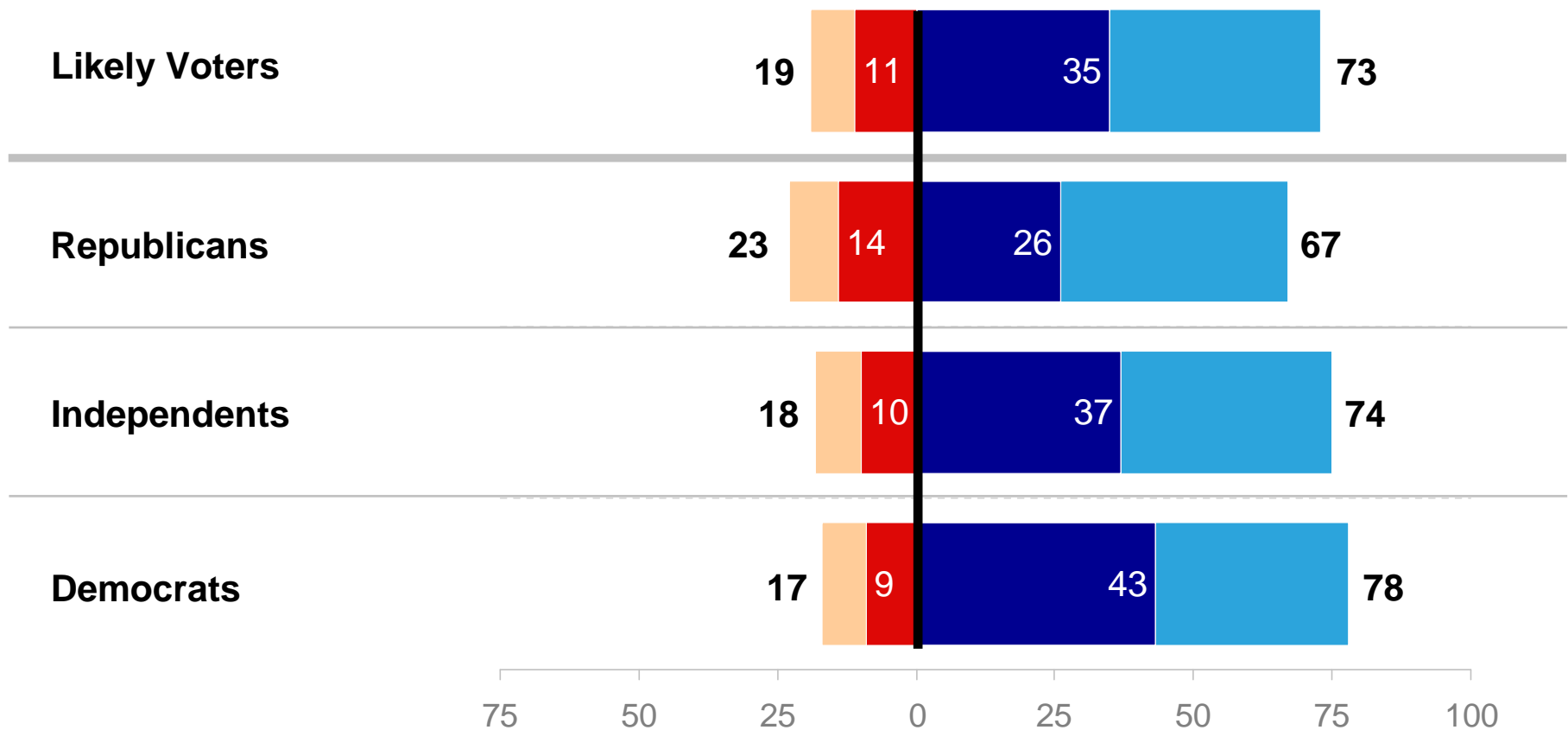

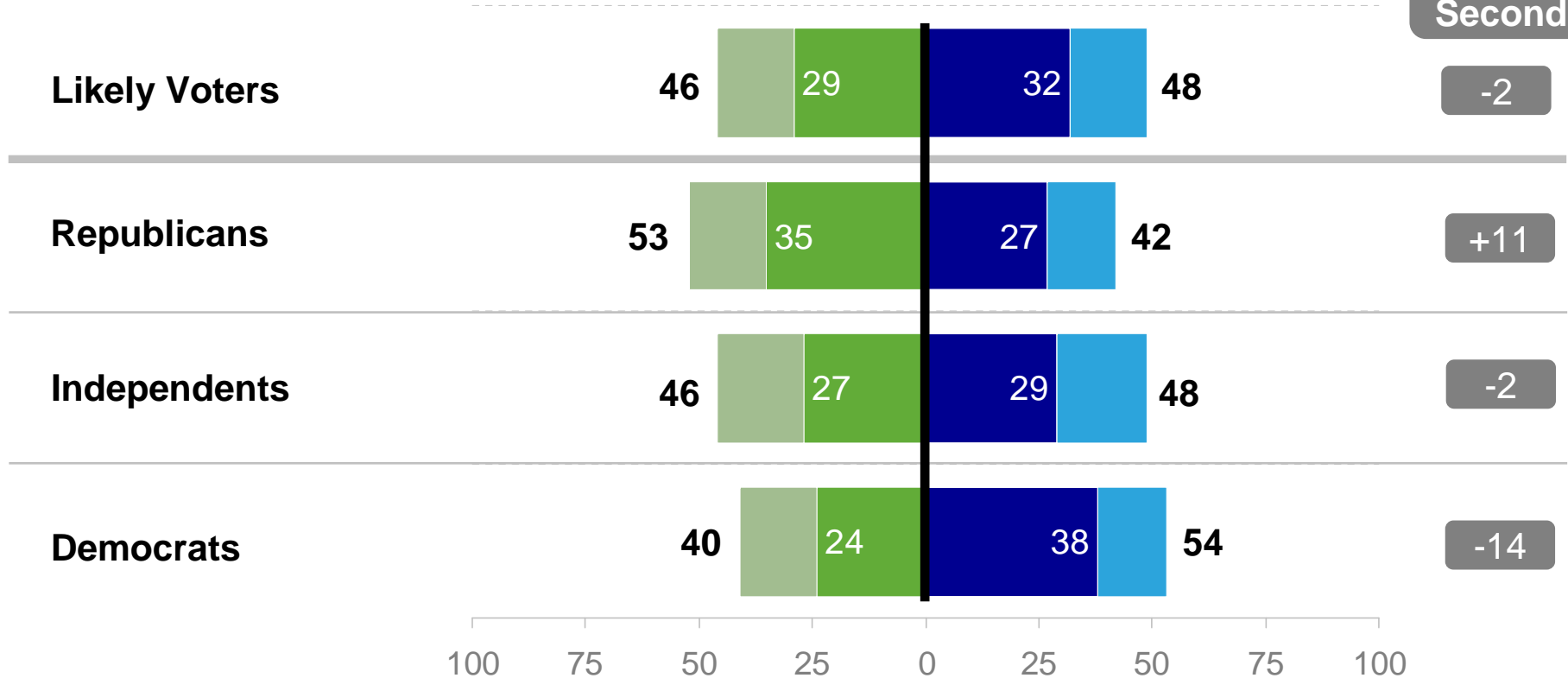

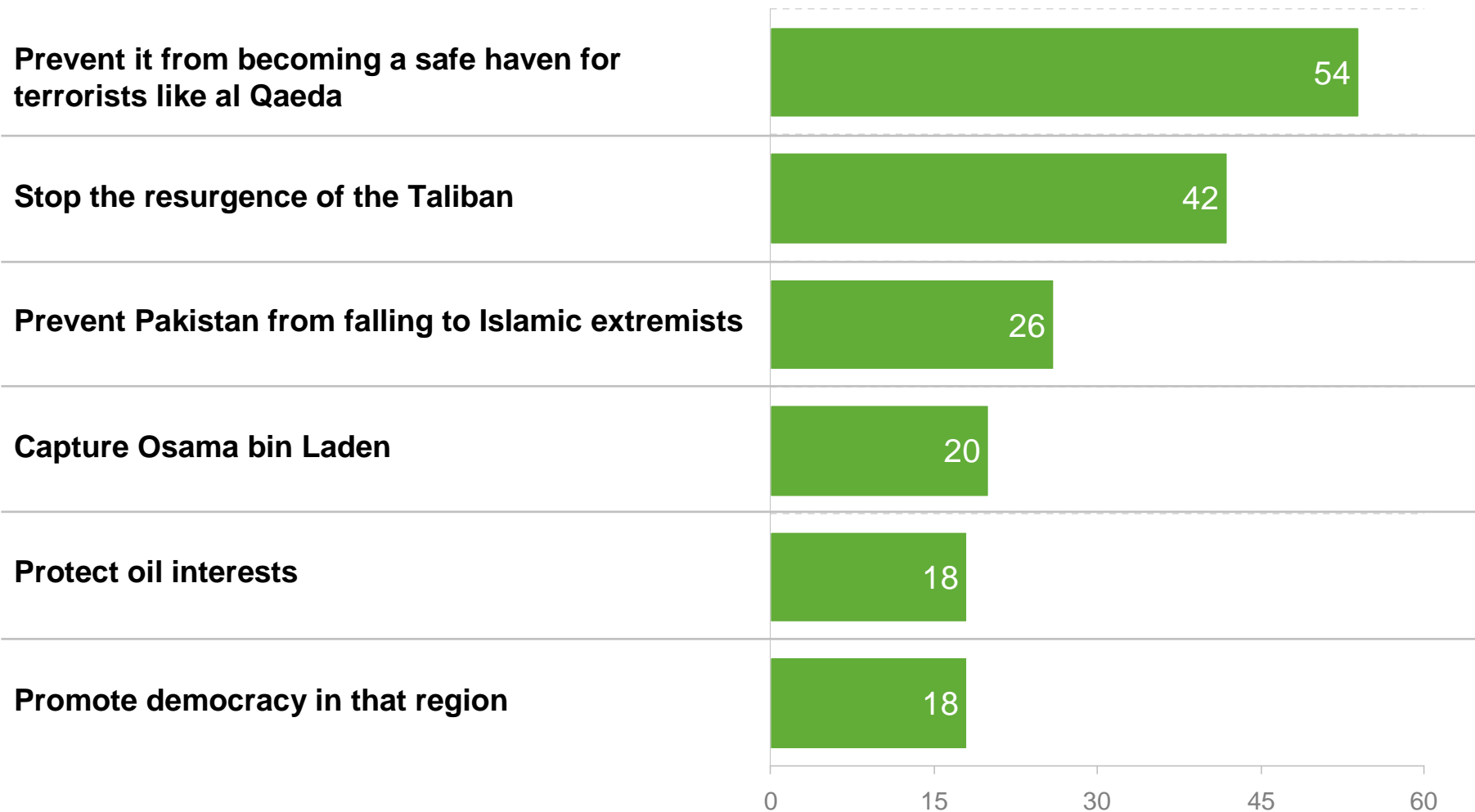

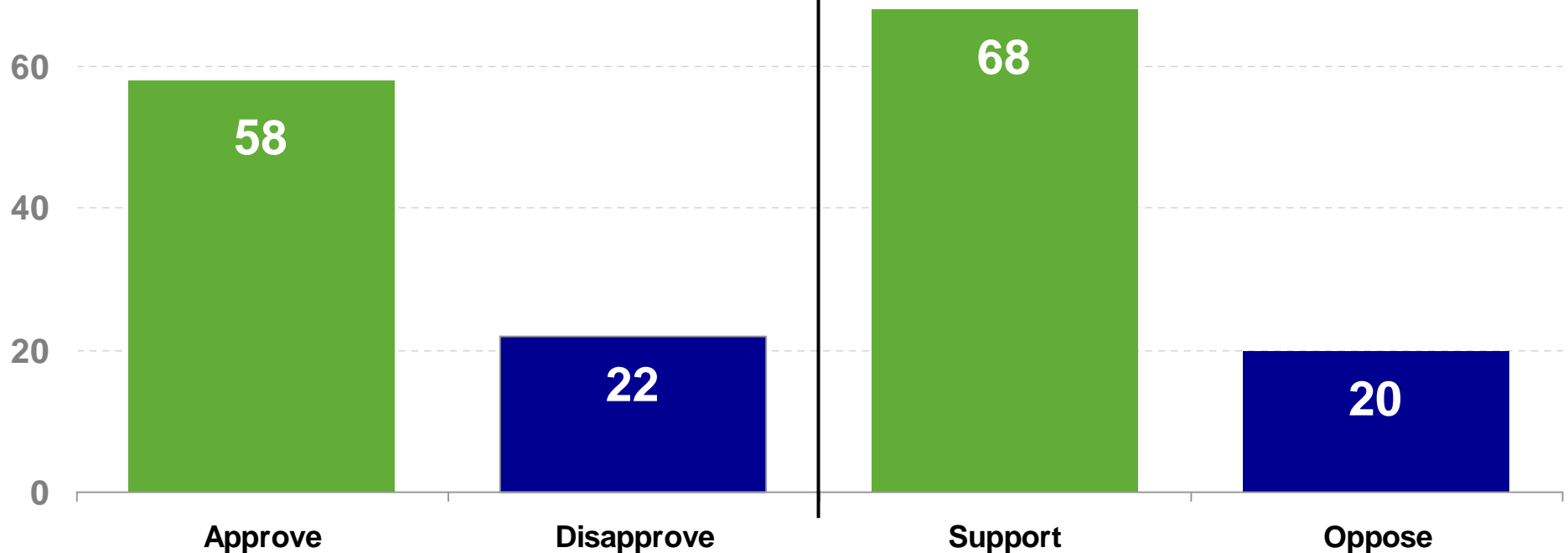

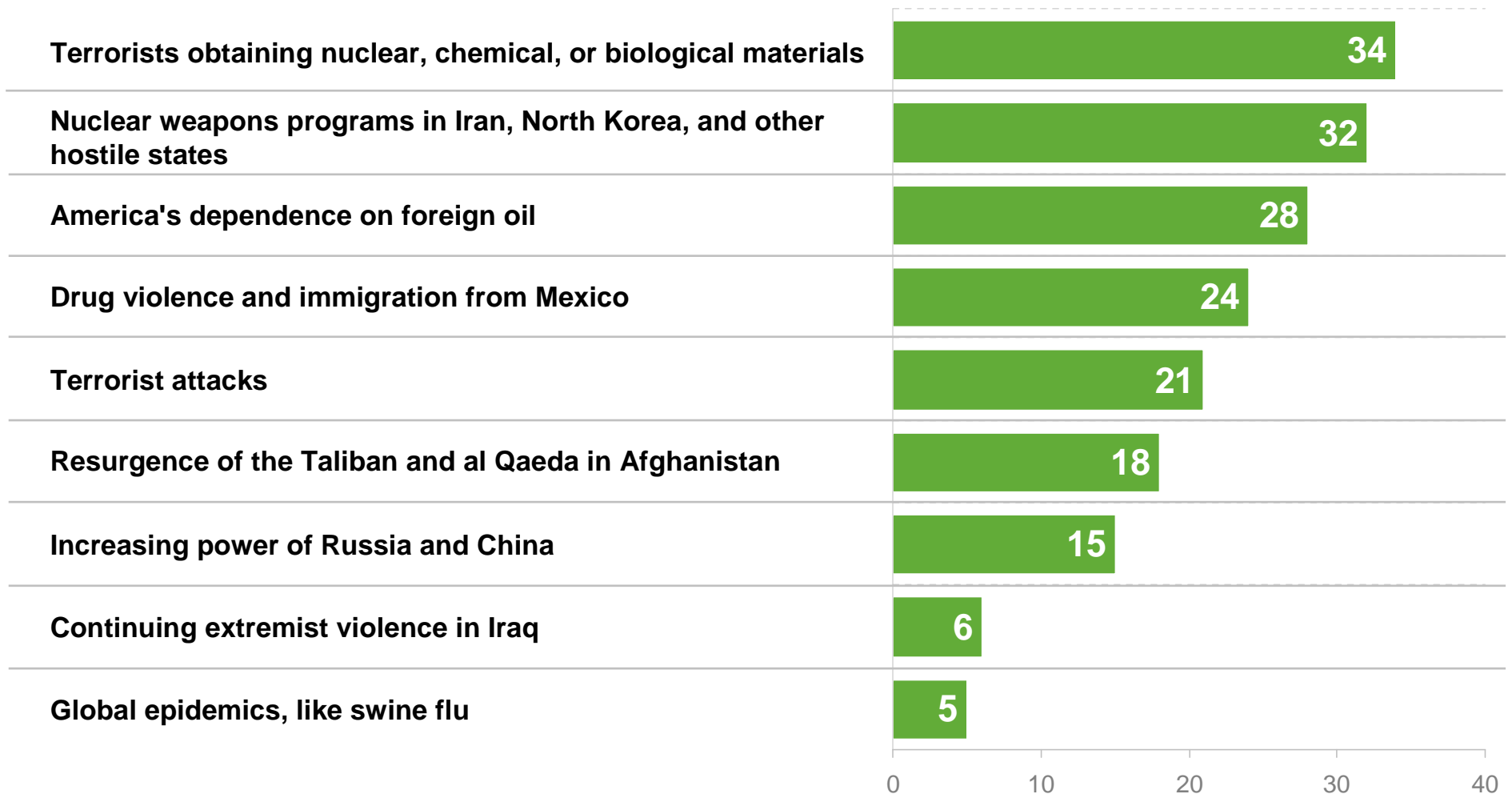

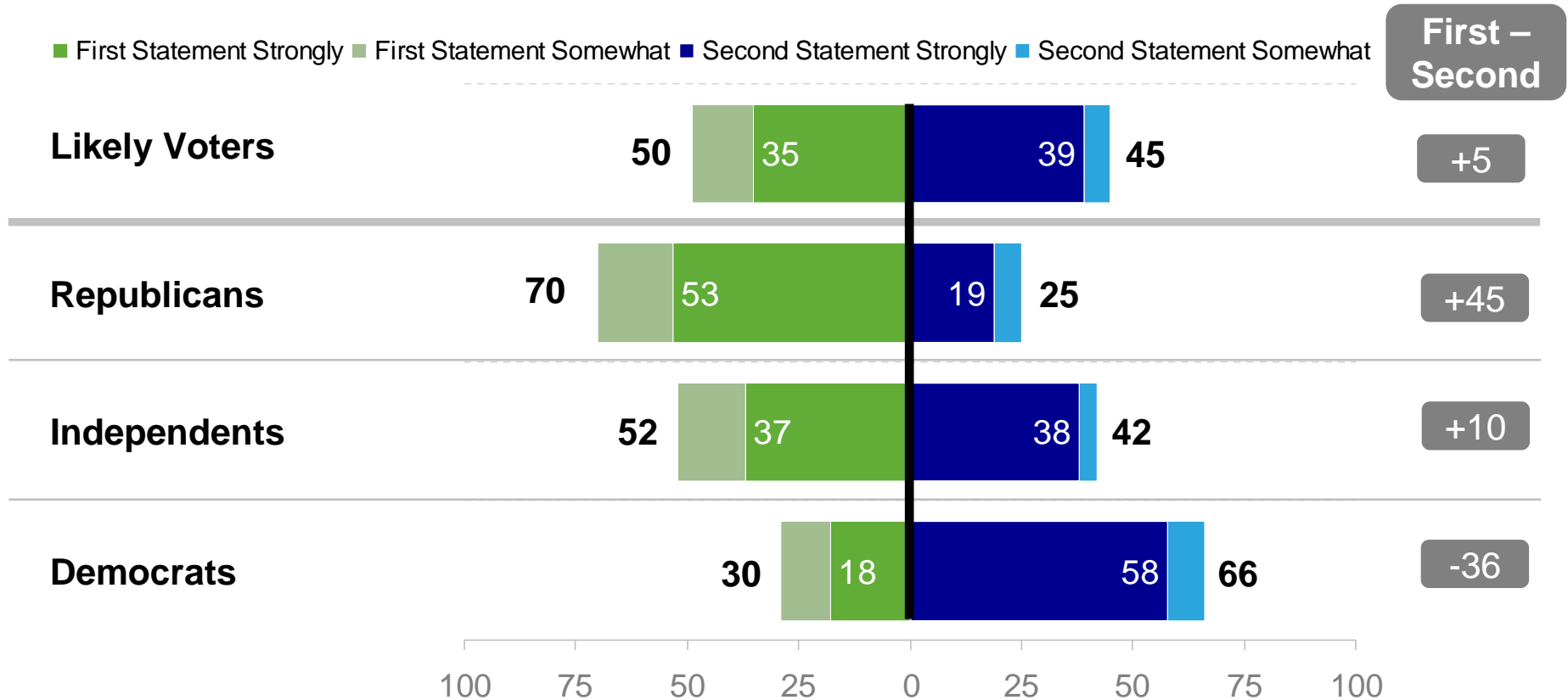
# Torture

**Second Statement:** It is never justified for American officials to use torture to get information from detainees.



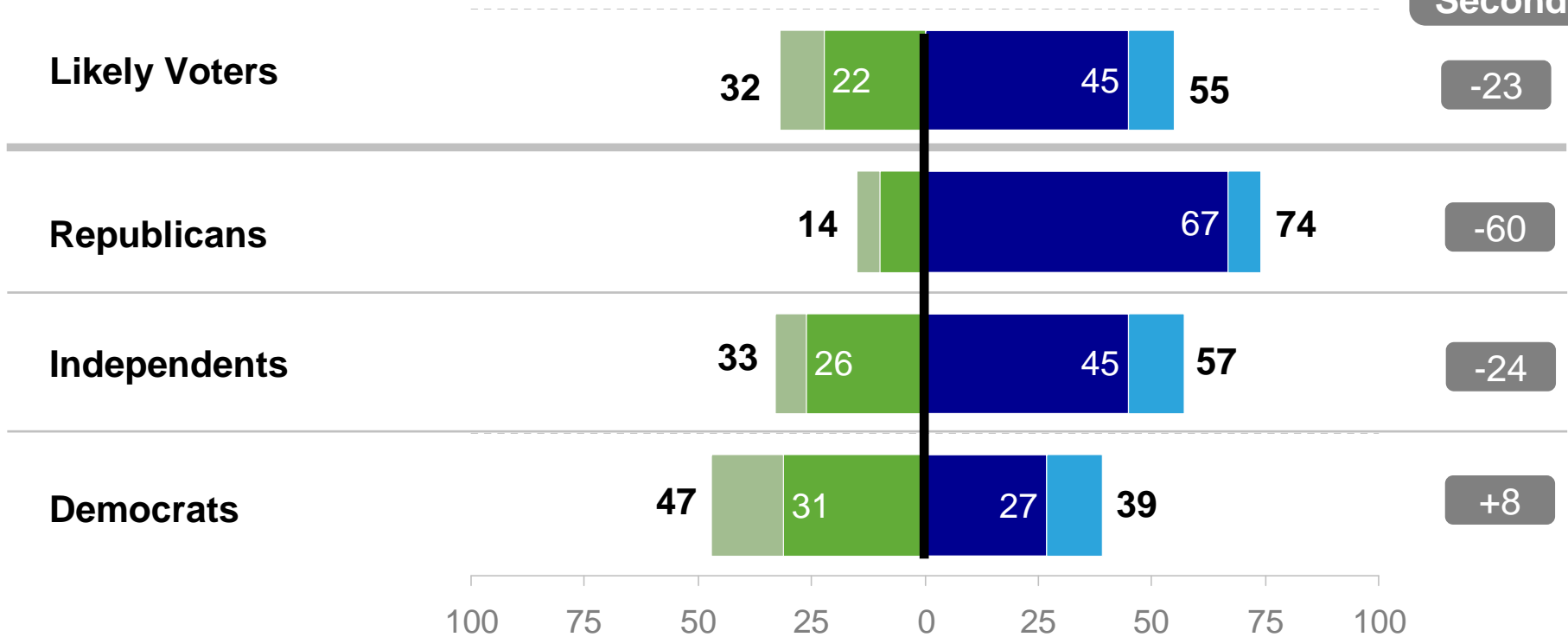
## Opposition to inquiry into Bush administration interrogation policies

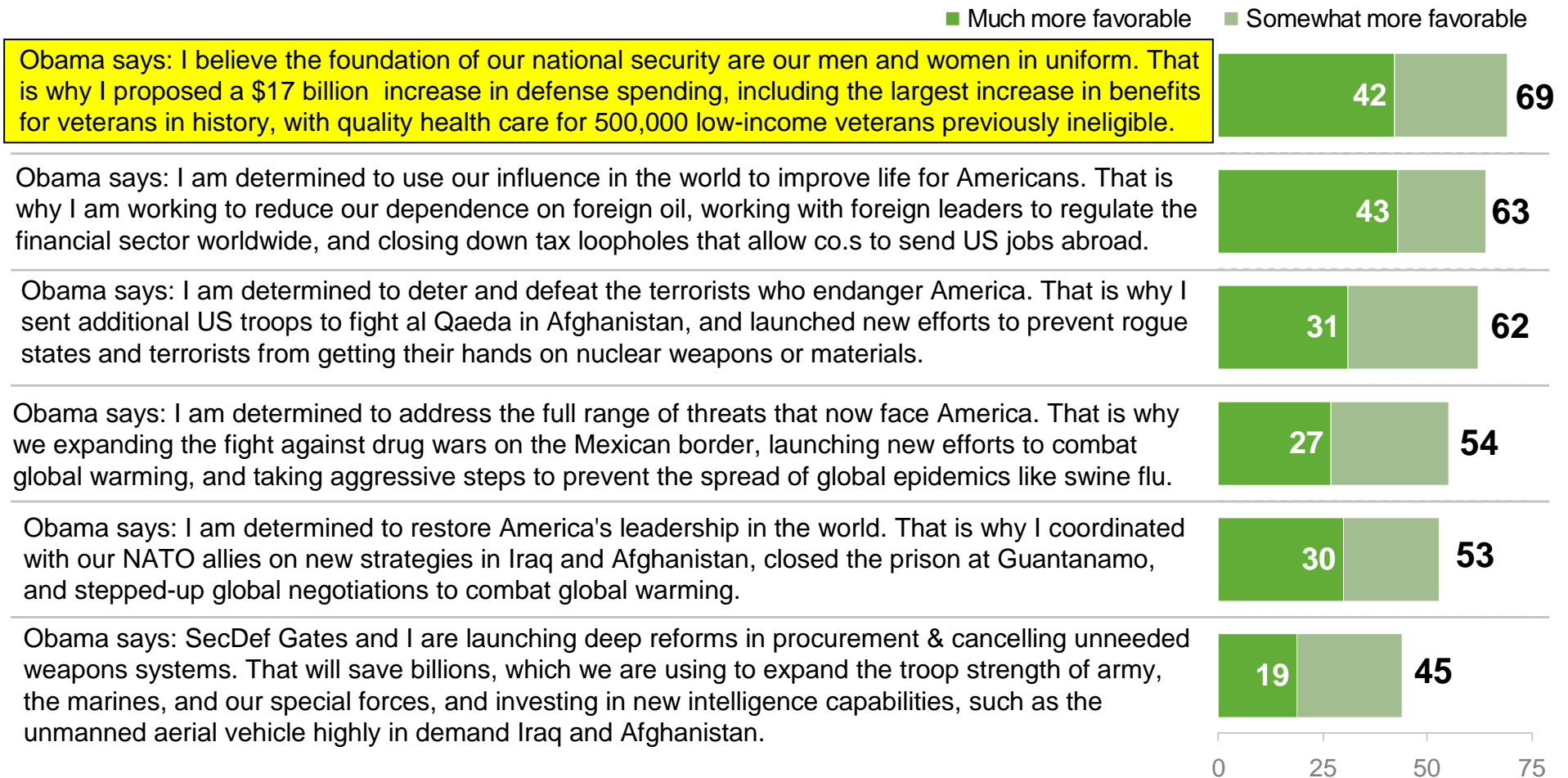

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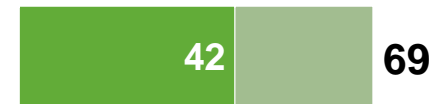

Obama says: I believe the foundation of our national security are our men and women in uniform. That is why I proposed a \$17 billion increase in defense spending, including the largest increase in benefits for veterans in history, with quality health care for 500,000 low-income veterans previously ineligible.



Obama says: I am determined to use our influence in the world to improve life for Americans. That is why I am working to reduce our dependence on foreign oil, working with foreign leaders to regulate the financial sector worldwide, and closing down tax loopholes that allow co.s to send US jobs abroad.



Obama says: I am determined to deter and defeat the terrorists who endanger America. That is why I sent additional US troops to fight al Qaeda in Afghanistan, and launched new efforts to prevent rogue states and terrorists from getting their hands on nuclear weapons or materials.



Obama says: I am determined to address the full range of threats that now face America. That is why we expanding the fight against drug wars on the Mexican border, launching new efforts to combat global warming, and taking aggressive steps to prevent the spread of global epidemics like swine flu.



Obama says: I am determined to restore America's leadership in the world. That is why I coordinated with our NATO allies on new strategies in Iraq and Afghanistan, closed the prison at Guantanamo, and stepped-up global negotiations to combat global warming.



Obama says: SecDef Gates and I are launching deep reforms in procurement & cancelling unneeded weapons systems. That will save billions, which we are using to expand the troop strength of army, the marines, and our special forces, and investing in new intelligence capabilities, such as the unmanned aerial vehicle highly in demand Iraq and Afghanistan.



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
