Methodology

On-going web-panel of Republicans in the battleground.

On November 3-16, Democracy Corps conducted the second in a series of two web-surveys among an on-going panel of 1,280 selfidentified Republicans and Republican-leaning independents in 12 states with Governor races (10 Senate races): Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, New Mexico, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee and Wisconsin.
